



Payment of Residence Fees

College residence fees are raised at the start of the academic year. Payment can be made in full or split into three equal instalments over the three terms. Your invoice will be sent to your Durham University e-mail address at the beginning of Term 1.

- Preferred method for UK Payments: BACS transfer.
- International students are encouraged to pay by Barclays-Transfermate, a payment option which allows International students to pay with no International bank charges, and a competitive foreign exchange rate. Please use link below:
